Kelly Ernby is a Deputy District Attorney. She started her 20-year legal career in the Orange County office of Gibson, Dunn and Crutcher, where she spent about 10 years as a business litigator before joining the Orange County District Attorney's office as a consumer and environmental protection prosecutor in 2011. She has argued (and won) twice in the California Supreme Court. She earned her Bachelors of Arts degree in Biological Sciences from the University of California Santa Barbara, her Juris Doctorate from the University of San Diego School of Law, and her Masters in Public Administration from the USC Price School of Public Policy. She was a Republican candidate for State Assembly in the 2020 primary and was elected to the OC GOP Central Committee, where she was recently appointed to serve as a member of the Executive Committee, and Chair of the OCGOP Precinct Operations and Voter Registration Committees.
